REIMBURSEMENT FORM

for Assessment of Commercial Equine Feed

Money from assessments on commercial equine feed is used for education, research, and promotional materials to help the Maryland equine industry. The Maryland Horse Industry Board also uses the funding to provide grants to such organizations as 4-H clubs, riding schools and local colleges. The assessment is calculated at a rate of \$6.00 per ton. On a 50-pound bag of feed, the assessment amounts to 15 cents.

Anyone who buys processed grain product equine feed in Maryland may request reimbursement of any assessment that was paid on the feed. The receipts you submit are not required to include an indication that the manufacturer or the retail has passed the fee on to the consumer. Purchasers may be reimbursed quarterly by submitting their commercial equine feed receipts to:
